To Whom It May Concern,

The Zionsville Police Department tested the Enviro-Save engine and powertrain protection metal treatment product initially in one 2006 Chevy Impala patrol car and an administrative 2008 Ford Explorer for 4 months. Per the instructions the product was added one time via the service openings under the hood for the Impala and through access points under the hood and undercarriage in the Explorer which required some mechanical knowledge and access. We manually recorded and tracked the mileage and fuel usage for two weeks prior to adding the product to achieve a baseline mpg then continued to manually monitor the mileage for 4 months. We did the manual tracking although we receive a printed report each month from our fuel supplier but find it not always accurate due to some user input inaccuracies.

After adding the product our Impala showed an improvement of 1-1.5 mpg with each tank as reported by the Officer. The variant we attribute to idling time. We noted the same improved mileage in the Explorer during periods of mostly city driving. At times where the Explorer was used for more highway miles we noted the fuel mileage improvement to be in the 2 mpg range. This represents an approximate 10 % improvement in the Impala MPG as we average 14-15 mpg. Based on these numbers I anticipate saving approximately \$13-15,000 in fleet fuel costs each year with no additional need for ongoing expenses for the Enviro-Save product beyond the one time application.

We have chosen to purchase Enviro-Save engine and powertrain protection metal treatment product for all of our current fleet vehicles (3 additional SUV's 4 Chargers and 18 Impala's) to see if we achieve the anticipated savings this year.

The savings in fuel costs is reason enough for justifying our purchase but we hope the metal treatment will also show a reduction in maintenance repairs.
